Our website and online services are owned and operated by Riverside Community Church (RCC). We care about how your information is used and shared. RCC will collect, use and protect the information you provide to us on our site. We will not use or share your information with anyone except as described in this Privacy Policy.

What We Collect and How We Use It

When you visit www.RCCLiveLoveLead.com, we may send you one or more tiny text files containing a string of characters, known as “cookies,” to uniquely identify your browser. Accepting our cookies allows you to keep your user preferences from session to session. Some features and services offered on our site may not function properly if you have cookies disabled.

Within our Website and Application, you have the ability to donate to RCC. Because we use a third party service to process banking and/or credit card information, we do not store verification numbers or credit card information on our server at any time.

How We Use Your Information

When you sign up for a particular service that requires registration, we ask you to provide personal information. Your email address is only used for current and future RCC program communications you've opted-in to receive. We never sell, share or spam.

Data Integrity

We review our data collection, storage and processing practices to ensure that we only collect, store and process the personal information needed to provide or improve our services. We take reasonable steps to ensure that the personal information we process is accurate, complete and current, but we depend on our users to update or correct their personal information whenever necessary.

Information Security

RCC takes reasonable steps to implement appropriate security measures to protect against unauthorized access to or unauthorized alteration, disclosure or destruction of data. These steps may include internal reviews of our data collection, storage and processing practices, as well as physical security measures to guard against unauthorized access to systems where personal data is stored. We restrict access to personal information to RCC employees, contractors and agents who may require this information to operate, develop or improve services. These individuals are bound by confidentiality obligations. RCC is not responsible if unauthorized access occurs; however, should a privacy issue arise, it is RCC's policy to investigate and cooperate to the fullest extent to resolve the issue.
